Comments: May 08, 2015 - JohnMay 08, 2015 - Scouter Paul@John - There is nothing in the new program that would prevent him from participating in the Arrow of Light program again. He would not wear two AoL patches on his uniform, just like any other multiply-earned award. That scout is ready to join a Boy Scout troop, and I'm curious what he would have done during 5th grade under the current program. I'd think it makes more sense to continue on with that original plan since he has completed Cub Scouting.May 08, 2015 - Scouter Joe@John that is quite the situation. I'm curious as to the unit set up. He would have some options, staying in Cub Scouts and do the new program, and earn the AoL over again OR what I think is the better option and move him on to a Boy Scout troop as Paul suggests. The new program, although vibrant, may be redundant for him. It's true the new program is asking more of the Scout but he will basically doing what the Scouts are doing any way but on a lesser level. Some state Boy Scout, some Tenderfoot!May 18, 2015 - Scouter Paul@Brian - A Webelos scout has earned no Boy Scout rank just by completing the Arrow of Light requirements. After completing all the AoL adventures, a Webelos scout will have done the 'skills' for the Scout rank, but he will have done those as a Cub Scout. It should be no problem for the scout to demonstrate them all to his new Scoutmaster, and a good Scoutmaster would want that time to get to know the new scout. Jun 10, 2015 - RobertWhen can the boys start working on the Arrow of Light requirements? Immediately after they earned their Webelos badge? For instance, my Webelos 1 den will have completed their Webelos badge by the Blue and Gold abnquet. Can we then start the AoL requirements or do we have to wait until the June 1st start of our scout year?Jul 22, 2015 - Joe@Robert - There is nothing in the transition material, the new Webelos handbook, or the new leader guide, which prevents a Webelos scout from earning any of the pins at any time. So your den can still earn AoL required pins BEFORE Webelos required pins if you so choose. The only change is that scouts joining in 5th grade do not have to complete the Webelos required pins or the extra two electives, but they still CAN if they want to, provided they have the opportunity (for instance, by working with the 4th grade Webelos den).Aug 15, 2015 - Brian LI am a webelos leader in an LDS pack and my son is one of my kids. in reading some of the posts above I believe I have gleaned some information as to my question but I want to confirm I dont want to set an incorrect precedence!My Son's B-day is March 19... at our pack meeting for august I expect him to earn his webelos badge, and that will leave him 1 section from completing his Arrow of Light - which he should have completed by september. I wanted to confirm if the time involved in the webelos and the Arrow of Light (3 and 6 Months respectively) can overlap - or if the minimum time involved is 9 months for both ... I asked this at a round table on thursday and there seemed to be some confusion!Aug 15, 2015 - Scouter Joe@Brian L The time cannot overlap and you are correct in saying that the minimum time that they can earn both the Webelos Rank and AoL is 9 months (3 months for Webelos and 6 months for Arrow of Light).Aug 15, 2015 - Scouter Paul@Brian - Scouter Joe's explanation of the 3 months and 6 months being consecutive is not how many other Packs have interpreted the requirement. There is no specification in the requirement wording that says the 3-month Webelos time needs to be completed before the 6-month AoL time begins. A new scout entering 5th grade right now could join a Webelos den and complete both Webelos and AoL by the end of February.Since you are in an LDS Pack, your den age divisions may impact how this works.It would be interesting to hear what other councils do, too.Aug 17, 2015 - Scouter Joe@Response that I received from National on the subject: Tenure is cumulative - 3 months while working on Webelos, 6 months while working on AoL. In cases where boys work across required adventures, the total tenure required is still 9 months.Aug 18, 2015 - Brian LThanks for the research - My suggestion is to make that an FAQ or an alert to all scout packs nationwide ... because as we have seen here (and I have seen locally) there is a lot of confusion on the fact!Aug 30, 2015 - Sunital have a Webelos 2 den that decided to continue with the old requirements in the old book for their 5th grade. We have 2 new 5th grade boys joining our den. There are opportunities to be efficient: for this year, boys working on AoL with the old program may use some of the new adventures as Sectives; the new boys may earn them as well, so there is no need for parallel programming in those cases.Sep 3, 2015 - AndrewCan the Webelos requied adventures be used as an AoL elective?Specifically, I would like my AoL's to take First Responder, because otherwise they wouldn't cover first aid stuff.Sep 14, 2015 - Scouter Joe@Andrew This year yes they could, though in the future (after next May) it would not be. First Responder is really close to Readyman, so if they have already have earned that activity badge then it would be pretty easy for them. Sep 15, 2015 - AndrewThese are new AoL scouts who did not do Readyman, because they just joined.I am so glad that AoL is a separate rank now, because I've had several fifth graders come and leave because of having to do both ranks.Oct 02, 2015 - NoelI have 5 boys who are finishish up the old webelos requirements. They will finish in February and cross over to Boy scout. During our recruitment, we had a 5th grader joining us. How can I help this kid. If he will be the only one doing the new requirements? Just the 6 months requirements will be March. The rest of the boys are graduating in February. So he will be the only one graduating in March, right?Oct 04, 2015 - Scouter Paul@Noel - See bottom of page 11 on Program Updates PDF - it will require individual coaching and individual efforts supervised by his parent. Many of the old Arrow of Light requirements are in the new Arrow of Light adventures, especially the Scouting adventure. As den leader, you can plan some activities that will fulfill both old and new requirements.Yes, he must be in the Webelos den for 6 months in order to receive the Arrow of Light rank. Oct 19, 2015 - SgtFitziHi so I am a new Cub Master with a pack that has 1 returning boy from last year who is a wolf. I am working with all new boys and none of them have been in Scouts before. I have 5 5th graders do I start them at webelos requirements or AoL requirements?Oct 22, 2015 - Scouter Joe@SgtFitzi Hello and congrats on entering Cub Scouting! You would have them all of course on the new program and with that you would have them start the AoL requirements.With the new program they would not need to earn their Webelos rank to earn their AoL, just their Bobcat rank if they are new.Nov 02, 2015 - GordonThe new 2nd yr program is called Arrow of light, but are the scouts being called arrow of lightmen as some have told me? I can't find that in the writing anywhere.Nov 02, 2015 - Scouter Paul@Gordon - You would need to be in writing because they are still called Webelos. You might let those other folks know that are incorrect.Nov 03, 2015 - Scouter Joe@Gordon There was a talk about those lines at Philmont last year but the staff has since recanted, that's where they are getting it from. Our Pack calls them Arrows, those they are still technically Webelos.Nov 15, 2015 - Kristy I have 2 boys in my pack that are both in 5th grade. One 10 and one 11. They have both earned the Webelos Badge and AoL under the old program and are getting bored with the new program this year, acting up and parents are causing a lot of unwanted drama in our Pack. Is there any rules or regulations on when they should crossing over once they have received their AOL? I cant find anything solid that isn't confusing.Nov 16, 2015 - Scouter Joe@Kristy - They can move up to Boy Scouts when the boys have earned the Arrow of Light rank and are at least 10 years old OR have completed the fifth grade and are at least 10, or who are 11, but not yet 18 years old.So it sounds like they are eligible to move up to Boy Scouts, especially if they are causing behavior problems.Award them their AOL at the next Pack Meeting and move them on!Dec 15, 2015 - John ThompsonI am a Unit Com for a pack. One boy is still in the 4th grade. His parents have assisted him as a Webelos II. Let's assume he has done all of the requirements for Arrow of Light, but he has not been active with the Webelos II Den [maybe attended 3 times since it started meetings last fall]. He will be 10 + 6 months on 3/17/2016. The Pack is having a cross over ceremony on 1/15/2016. 1) Can he participate in the cross over ceremony to the troop on 1/15/2016? or does he have to wait until he is 10 & 1/2 years old? [Assuming he has his AOL!2] Can he do the crossover 6 months after receiving his AOL, if he has not yet earned it?3) If he has been as inactive as he apparently has, Can his work [totally with his parents] to earn is Webelos Award [and possibly his AOL] be acceptable to the BSA even though he has had little participation with the Webelos Den? 4) Can he do the crossover with other Webelos II Scouts who are in the 5th grade on 1/15/2016, but then just not participate in troop activities until he is 10 1/2 years old on 3/17/2016?Dec 16, 2015 - Scouter Paul@John - Boy Scouts entering Cub Scouts in the 5th grade or 2nd year of Webelos in a traditional unit. There will be those who would want to push the rules, so the above rule is meant to encourage scouts to be active from the start. Feb 10, 2016 - KristinCan the new 2016 program for Webelos, can the 2 electives required for this badge also be used for AOL? Or do the boys need 3 different electives for the AoL?Feb 11, 2016 - Scouter Paul@Kris - No, see FAQ page. Feb 12, 2016 - Sharon DustinI an LDS unit can boys receive the AOL as an 11 year old scout?Mar 04, 2016 - Scouter Joe@Sharon No they can not. 11 year old Scouts in LDS units have already moved on to Boy Scouts and can no longer earn Cub Scout awards.May 20, 2016 - CM SteveHello - I am a new CM this year and I have a Webelos rank question. We have 3-4 boys who are close, but have not yet completed the Webelos rank requirements after their first Webelos year. Given the length of the Webelos program compared to the younger ranks, can they still earn (and receive) their rank after June 1, or do they "advance" and only work on AoL adventures?May 20, 2016 - Scouter Paul@Steve - A new boy can join your Pack in 5th grade and still earn the Webelos rank and AoL. A scout in a Webelos den can take 4th and 5th grade to earn his Webelos rank.Jul 31, 2016 - Christa CampbellI have a question:My boys just returned from AoL camp and they had a new requirement that I do not see listed on my Webelos Trax no have I heard of it. It is called Shooting Sports. Would you know about it and if it is truly a new requirement I can count towards their AOL rank?Thank you!ChristaJul 31, 2016 - Scouter Paul@Christa - Sounds like you are referring to Shooting Sports award. It is not an Arrow of Light requirement. It is a separate award. Sep 07, 2016 - KevinI have a boy that just joined. He is in the fourth grade. He was held back one year so he should be in 5th grade. He's just made 10. 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
